5. Admissions & Enrollment Policy

Detroit Extravagant Academy provides equal educational opportunities to qualified applicants.

6. Program Descriptions & Course Outlines

Detroit Extravagant Academy offers programs designed to provide students with career-ready knowledge, professional skills, and practical experience.

Cosmetology Program

Program Length: 1500 Hours

Program Description & Objective: This course will highlight the history of cosmetology, hair cutting, hair color, hair styling, salon ecology, chemistry of cosmetics, basic manicure/pedicure, skin theory, skin care, and more.

Barber Program

Program Length: 1800 Hours

Program Description & Objective: This course will highlight the history of barbering, hair cutting, hair styling, and more.

Manicuring Program

Program Length: 600 Hours

Program Description & Objective: This course will highlight the history of manicuring, manicures/pedicures, acrylics, gels, wraps, nail art, and more.

Natural Hair Cultivation Program

Program Length: 400 Hours

Program Description & Objective: This course will highlight natural hair treatment, salon ecology, chemistry of cosmetics, basic manicure/pedicure, skin theory, skin care, and more.

Esthetics Program

Program Length: 750 Hours

Program Description & Objective: This course will highlight the history esthetics, lashes, facials, skin care, and more.

Instructor Trainee Program

Program Length: 500 Hours

Program Description & Objective: The Instructor Course is presented as the art and practice of teaching to help the individual identify resources and to stimulate through the process by which teaching can be made effective and stimulating. The course will also highlight public speaking, audiovisual aids, Board of Cosmetology Rules and Regulations, teaching methods, Lesson planning, and Testing/Grading

7. Graduation Requirements

Students must complete all institutional requirements to graduate.

Graduation requirements include:

- Successful completion of all required courses per the State of Michigan guidelines.
- Meeting minimum academic standards
- Completion of required clock hours
- Meeting attendance requirements
- Payment of all financial obligations
- Completion of required examinations or assessments

Students who successfully complete all requirements will receive a certificate of completion/diploma.

8. Grading System & Standards of Progress

Detroit Extravagant Academy evaluates students based on academic performance, attendance, participation, and skill mastery.

Grading Scale:

A = 90–100% Excellent

B = 80–89% Good

C = 70–79% Satisfactory

D = 60–69% Below Standard

F = Below 60% Failure

Students must maintain satisfactory academic progress throughout enrollment.

Students are expected to:

- Complete assignments on time
- Participate in classroom activities
- Demonstrate required skills
- Maintain required grade averages

9. Academic Probation, Suspension & Reentrance Policy

Students who fail to maintain satisfactory academic progress may be placed on academic probation.

Probation Process:

1. Student receives written notification.
2. Student meets with administration.
3. Improvement plan is developed.
4. Progress is reviewed during probation period.

Students who fail to improve may face academic suspension.

Students seeking reentry must:

- Submit request for reinstatement
- Meet with administration
- Demonstrate readiness to continue successfully

10. Attendance Policy

Regular attendance is necessary for successful completion.

Excused Absences

Examples include:

- Illness
- Medical appointments
- Family emergencies
- Approved circumstances

Documentation may be required.

Unexcused Absences

Failure to attend without approval may be considered unexcused.

Tardiness

Students arriving late may be marked tardy.

Repeated tardiness may result in counseling or disciplinary action.

Excessive Absences

Students who fail to meet attendance standards may:

- Receive written warnings
- Be placed on attendance probation
- Face dismissal from the program

Make-Up Work

Students are responsible for arranging completion of missed assignments, coursework, and training hours.

11. Student Conduct & Dismissal Policy

Students are expected to maintain professional conduct.

Prohibited behavior includes:

- Disrespect toward staff or students
- Harassment or discrimination
- Academic dishonesty
- Violence or threats
- Property damage
- Violation of school policies

Disciplinary action may include:

1. Verbal warning
2. Written warning
3. Probation
4. Dismissal

12. Credit for Prior Education & Training Policy

Detroit Extravagant Academy evaluates previous education and training, including military training, when applicable.

Students requesting credit must provide:

- Official transcripts
- Certificates
- Training documentation

Approved credit may reduce program requirements and completion time.

Written documentation will be maintained in the student record.
